Thank you to everyone who joined in with our Christmas fundraising last term. We raised a fabulous £890 on the raffles and Christmas events, thank you! This money helped to provide Christmas parties, entertainment and bought gifts for all the nursery children.

A few reminders

Snack money is £2 of 15hour children and £2.50 for 30hour children, this is paid to your child's key person. Snack money for paid 2s is included in fees.

When dropping off *please close the doors into the main nursery rooms* behind you, as children are playing in these areas.

When leaving the building **please hold your child's hand**, we do not want anyone to come to harm on the road and there is a constant flow of cars.

Please **write your child's name in the clothing** they wear to nursery. It is very difficult to find lost property when it does not have a name in it.

Please try your best to **arrive on or before 9am**. The 3-4year nursery children have their taught group activity at this time. Those children arriving late are missing out on this valuable time and it can be upsetting for the children to arrive when everyone else has begun.

Blue teddies bags need to be clearly named and hung on coat pegs in the bathroom area. Only children who are in nappies or toilet training need to bring bags to nursery as coat peg space is limited.

The nursery garden is always accessed by the children, so please encourage your child to be independent in dressing for outdoors. Let them put their own coats and hats on each day, having a go is the best way of learning. As the weather can be unpredictable, there will be times we will use the hall for movement, dance and games etc. We ask the children to take their shoes and socks off for these activities. Please practise these skills at home with your child. Socks and tights can be tricky for little fingers. Why not let your child have a go at their socks and shoes when dressing on a morning.

There will be a **bring and buy cake sale** on the 30th January to raise money towards replacing the pergola roof in the 3-4 year olds garden.

We will continue to explore changing seasons and different cultures, celebrating Chinese New Year with a Red day. After half term you will be invited into Nursery for parents consultations and we will be be holding our 'Cuddle up with a book' Mother's Day event from 8.45am.

There will be a chocolate raffle to raise funds for the nursery Easter Pyjama Party and an egg hunt at the end of the term.

All the dates for the term are included in the calendar attached, on the nursery website and ourschools app.

We will be launching our new toothbrushing scheme at the end of January. To coincide with this all children attending for packed lunches will no longer need to provide a drink. We will be offering milk and water for all the children.
