Sharing Our Journey Through Nursery

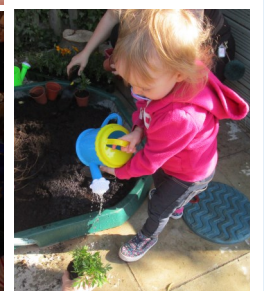
