This term we are developing a new way of working in partnership with our families to share children's learning. We will not be offering a parent consultation evening as we will be meeting with a small number of families each week throughout the year. More information on this will be available to you soon.

Our Nursery Curriculum.

The curriculum we offer in our school is built around the children's interests, identified by our highly skilled team of nursery practitioners. We develop the whole child—learning to be confident, sociable, independent and inquisitive. Having a positive attitude and making positive relationships.

We value partnerships with home and will have opportunities for you to come and join in with nursery events. This term events will be outdoors due to COVID infections rates locally. If you would like to volunteer, we would really appreciate help with our activity pack library. This would be in a separate room to nursery children and would follow a COVID risk assessment. Please speak to a member of the nursery team if you are interested.

To raise funds for Christmas events and to help us buy some new lunchtime outdoor coats we will be running a sponsored football skills event in November. Thank you for all your help with fundraising, we really value your support.

We intend to introduce the children to different cultures by looking at celebrations of light across the world.

We will be teaching our children about helping others by sending donated second hand coats to Wrap Up Uk and a group of children will buy some Christmas gifts to donate to Mission Christmas (for children in our local community who would otherwise not receive a gift).

A few polite reminders

When leaving the school grounds **please hold your child's hand**, we do not want anyone to come to harm on the road and there is a constant flow of cars.

Please **write your child's name in the clothing** they wear to nursery. It is very difficult to find lost property when it does not have a name in it.

Please try your best to **arrive at or before 9am**. The 3-4year nursery children have their taught group activity at this time. Those children arriving late are missing out on this valuable time.

Snack money is £2 for 15hour children and £2.50 for 30hour children, this is paid to your child's key person. Snack money for paid 2s is included in fees.

Changing bags need to be clearly named on the outside please. Only children who are in nappies or toilet training need to bring bags to nursery as coat peg space is limited.
